OFFICE MEMORANDUM

All the curfew passes electronic or physical issued by the office of Commissioner of Police will continue to be valid till 20th of April without any further action. The policemen at the field level needs to be informed and sensitised about it immediately. Electronic passes will show validity as 14th April but it should be automatically deemed as 20th of April.

The system of emergency manual/electronic day passes (to be issued by each Police Station) needs to be supervised closely because citizens who have patiently waited till 14th April will be dis-appointed to some extent and agitated more than before. These passes should continue to be given as per the system already prevailing. Matter will be reviewed again after 20th April, 2020.
