**Subject: Regulation of movement of persons from other states to Karnataka**

For controlling spread of Covid-19 pandemic, following directions are issued under section 24(l) of The Disaster Management Act 2005 and section 2(1) of The Epidemic Diseases Act 1897 to regulate movement of persons from other states to Karnataka, in partial modification of the Order number RD 158 TNR 2020 (P1) issued on 03.06.2020.

**1. Quarantine Norms:**

- a. Persons coming from Maharashtra shall be placed in 7-day institutional quarantine followed by 7-day home quarantine.
- b. Persons coming from Delhi or Tamil Nadu shall be placed in 3-day institutional quarantine followed by 11-day home quarantine.
- c. Persons coming from states other than Maharashtra, Delhi and Tamil Nadu shall be placed in 14-day home quarantine.
- d. The other quarantine norms including those for business travelers, transit travelers and special category travelers shall be in accordance with the protocol issued by Health & family Welfare Department vide document number SOP4/IST/2 dated 08.06.2020, which is annexed to this order.

**2. Registration on Seva Sindhu portal:**

- a. The registration on Seva Sindhu portal is mandatory for all persons coming in or transiting through Karnataka by providing correct information about their contact number and destination address.
  - b. All transport companies such as airlines, railways and, road transport companies are required to ensure that their passengers have done the registration on Seva Sindhu portal for the relevant mode of transport before boarding the flight, train or bus.
3. Any violation of the quarantine norms or failure to register on Seva Sindhu portal or giving of incorrect information by the incoming persons or carrying of passengers by the transport companies without registration on the portal shall attract penal action as per section 51(b) of The Disaster Management Act 2005 and section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

## Inter State Travellers Guidelines (Order dated 16.06.2020)

### Mandatory Self registration by all travellers on Seva Sindhu

- Name, address mobile number to be provided
- Business Travellers: Provide name, mobile, address of person in KA you are intended to meet and return date
- Transit Travellers: Provide address in destination state indicate exit check point of KA

### Quarantine Norms

#### Symptomatic on Arrival (Any State)

- 7 Days of Hospital isolation at Covid Care Centre
- Testing Immediately on arrival
- If positive, Shift to dedicated Covid Hospital
- If negative, no further test required

#### Asymptomatic on Arrival

**Returnees from Maharastra** 7 Days IQ followed by 7 days HQ

**Returnees from Delhi and TN** 3 days IQ followed by 11 days HQ

(Boarding flight/Train from MH,DL, TN will be considered for above quarantine rules)

- Testing only if develops symptoms
- Special Category asymptomatic will be sent to HQ with one attendant, testing once between 5th or 7th Day of arrival (Special category: Pregnant Women/Children aged 10 and below/elderly aged 60 and above/Serious illness/Death in the family/Human Distress)
- Covid19 Negative test certificate from ICMR approved lab and latest by 2 days will be exempted from IQ and referred to 14 days HQ

#### **Returnees from other States**

- 14 days of HQ
- Test if symptoms develop during HQ
- Institutional Quarantine if Large family or no separate room for HQ  
Or returnee is from Slum or over crowded area where HQ not possible

#### **Business Traveller/Short time visitors from other State**

- show confirmed return flight/train ticket which should not be more than 7 days later from the date of arrival. If coming by road, provide the address proof of person you are intended to meet.
- If business visitors coming for short duration of 48 hrs( counted from arrival time) he/she is Exempted from Covid19 test & quarantine.
- If staying for more than 48 hrs and less than 7 days, then Covid19 test is done, swab will be drawn immediately on arrival, person needs to wait in IQ, after getting negative report such person can complete his work and go back.
- If he/she is coming with covid19 negative report, from ICMR approved lab, which is not more than 2 days old, such person is exempted from testing & quarantine.
- No hand stamping

#### **Business Travellers of KA going out to other States**

- Returning within 4 days (from the day of journey) no testing & no quarantine after returning
- Returning after 4 days should follow quarantine protocol as per para 3(II) (A&B)
- No hand stamping

#### **Transit traveller from other states**

- Show flight/train ticket for onward journey which should not be more than 1 day later from arrival
- Travelling by Road, provide id proof and address proof of destination state.
- The traveller should get his exit recorded at the selected exit check post/railway station/airport
- Transit Travellers by road will be hand stamped "Transit Traveller"
