## **THE IMPORTANCE OF ELECTORAL ROLL**

The ELECTORAL ROLL is the most important document when it comes to elections. A person can vote during the election only if the person's name appears in an electoral roll. Hence, it is extremely important that every eligible voter is registered in the relevant electoral roll.

Please note that it is not mandatory to have a Voter ID Card or a Voter ID No. for a person's name to appear in an electoral roll.

An electoral roll is uniquely identified by the following information –

1. Part No. / Polling Station No. & Polling Station Address
2. Ward No. & Ward Name
3. Assembly Constituency No. & Assembly Constituency Name
4. Parliamentary Constituency No. & Parliamentary Constituency Name

Each electoral roll usually has up to 1,200 voters, each person uniquely identified by a Serial No.

## **HOW TO IDENTIFY THE ELECTORAL ROLL(S) FOR YOUR APARTMENT COMPLEX**

The list of voters in an apartment complex could be registered in a single or multiple electoral rolls, depending on the size of the apartment complex as well as a few other factors. To identify your electoral roll which contains details of your polling station, ward, assembly constituency & parliamentary constituency, you can take the voter id number of one or more residents of your apartment association and follow the steps given below:

1. Go to the website [ceokarnataka.kar.nic.in](http://ceokarnataka.kar.nic.in)
2. Scroll below and click on "Search my Name in Voter List" in the "I want to" section
3. Click on "Search with EPIC Number"
4. Click on "Bangalore" against District, Enter Voter ID No. against EPIC No. & click Search
5. Please note down the ACNO, Assembly Constituency & PartNo
6. You can now go back to the home page of [ceokarnataka.kar.nic.in](http://ceokarnataka.kar.nic.in)
7. Scroll below and click on "View – Electoral Rolls" in the "I want to" section
8. Click on "View – Final Electoral Rolls – 2017"
9. Click on "Bangalore" in the list of districts appearing
10. Click on the relevant District Name "B.B.M.P. (CENTRAL)" or "B.B.M.P. (NORTH)" or "B.B.M.P. (SOUTH)" or "BANGALORE URBAN"
11. Click on the relevant Assembly Constituency that you had noted down earlier. If you are not able to find your Assembly Constituency, go back and click on a different District Name.
12. Click on the Polling Station Name listed against your PartNo, which you noted down earlier.
13. You will get the Electoral Roll relevant for your apartment which you can download.
14. The first page of the Electoral Roll will have the Polling Station / Part No., Ward No., Assembly Constituency No. & Parliamentary Constituency No.
15. Please update these details against your apartment in the Google form that you would have received from Bangalore Apartments' Federation (BAF)!
